## Candidate for Mayor

In this reading, two mayoral candidates are talking about their future plans after being selected. The first candidate is Daniel Baker, a democrat, and the second one is Gabriela Soto, a republican.

1. Is Daniel Baker a Republican?

2. What did Daniel promise to do four years ago?

3. Does Daniel think that the job is finished?

4. What will happen if Daniel is reelected?

5. What is Daniel's first priority? And why?
