AUDIOSCRIPT

Interviewer Tonight, we're talking to Elena Stern. Elena has just finished her exams and she is taking a gap year, that is, a year off before going to university. Elena, welcome to the programme. Can you tell me why you decided to take a gap year?

Elena I want to travel and if I go straight to university, I probably won't get the opportunity again. But the most important reason is that I'm not sure what I want to study. If I take a year off, I'll have time to decide.

I What are you going to do during your gap year?

It's a volunteer job, so I won't get paid. I love children and I've thought about teaching as a career. Working at the school will be a good test. I'm planning to stay there for six weeks then I'll travel a bit. I'd love to go on a safari.

I Are you planning to stay in Africa or will you go somewhere else?

Elena I'm going to spend some time with relatives in South Africa. My father was born in Cape Town, but I've never been there. It's the perfect opportunity to meet my cousins for the first time. I'm so excited – I can't wait to meet them! I hope to stay there for a month before going to India.

I India? What are you going to do there?

Elena I'd like to do volunteer work on a tiger conservation programme in a national park. But they get thousands of applications so I don't know if they'll take me. If they don't, I'll just visit the parks, and then I'll have to come home.

I Have you got any idea what you'll do when you come home?

Elena I originally wanted to be a vet, so that's still a possibility. Anything might happen in the next year. I might get a dream job in a national park and stay in India!

I How do you think you've done in your exams?

Elena I'm optimistic. I think I'll get fairly good results. But I won't know until August and I'm going to apply for university in January.
