#### What is appropriate office attire?

Companies in many parts of the world are relaxing the rules about what is appropriate to wear to work. The days of conservative suits for everyone in business are gone. Many U.S. companies have "casual Friday," a day when less conservative attire is acceptable. Many people in the computer world wear casual clothes all the time. In warmer climates, people who work in offices frequently

wear less conservative clothing than people in colder climates. Short-sleeved shirts with no ties or jackets are traditional for men in some parts of Asia. Sandals or flats with no pantyhose can be appropriate for women in warmer climates. Some companies have dress codes, but even those that don't have unwritten rules about what is and is not appropriate office attire.
